

Junior High Dress Code Guidelines 2017 - 2018

1. Hairstyles should be simple, neat, and clean; **extremes are to be avoided. Bleached, streaked, highlighted, or otherwise-colored hair IS NEVER PERMITTED.** Boys' hair must be above and not touch the shirt collar and should be trimmed around the ears. Crew cuts, flat tops, etc. must not exceed **one inch**. Boys' and girls' hair should be neat; bangs are to be above the eyebrows. The principal makes the final decision regarding the appropriateness of the hairstyle. Students will not be allowed to enter their classroom if the hairstyle is deemed inappropriate. Students will be welcomed back to school when the hairstyle is acceptable.
2. No make-up, tattoo, or nail polish is permitted. One pair of stud earrings for girls is acceptable. Boys may not wear earrings. Students may wear a wristwatch (alarms/signals off) and one religious medal or cross. No other jewelry is acceptable.
3. Students must wear uniforms that are neat and clean, reflecting pride in themselves and in their school. Ill-fitting (oversized/baggy or too tight/short) shirts, pants, or shorts are not permitted.
 - a. **Boys** must wear the Norman's yellow knit polo shirt and navy blue pants or navy blue walking shorts, both with Norman's label. Boys' pants must be worn at the waist and not reach the floor (while standing with shoes off.)
 - b. **Girls** must wear the Norman's yellow knit polo shirt and plaid skirt or navy blue walking shorts, both with Norman's label. Girls' skirts may not be rolled at the waist and must be no more than three inches above the middle of the knee (measured from the floor when kneeling.) **We recommend that girls' skirts be NO MORE THAN TWO INCHES above the knee in September to allow for growth during the year.** The walking shorts must reach mid-thigh. Rolled skirts or shorts will earn an automatic detention.
 - c. On P.E. days, students must wear the school P.E. uniform from Norman's. This uniform has the school logo and includes the forest green sweatshirt, the yellow P.E. shirt, and the navy blue P.E. shorts or green sweatpants.
 - i. Shorts must have an inseam of a minimum of five inches and must not extend below the knee.
 - ii. Walking shorts are NOT permitted on P.E. days.
 - iii. The uniform P.E. shorts may be worn with the regular uniform school shirt in September and October.
4. Athletic shoes and shoelaces that are WHITE, BLACK, and/or GRAY are acceptable. NO OTHER COLOR shoes, shoelaces, trim, design, or logos may be worn. Slip-on shoes are also not acceptable. Shoelaces must be laced and tied properly. Athletic shoes must be worn on P.E. days.
5. Boys' socks must be solid white, black, or navy blue. Girls may wear solid white, yellow, navy blue, black, or forest green socks. Girls may wear white, navy blue, black, or forest green tights under their skirts. **Logos/designs are not permitted on socks and tights.**
6. The school sweatshirt (forest green with the school logo) or school cardigan is acceptable in the classroom. No other sweatshirt, jacket, or sweater may be worn in the classroom. On very cold days, students may wear a plain, white long-sleeved turtleneck shirt under the school yellow polo shirt. A jacket, including the optional uniform school jacket, may be worn over the school sweatshirt or sweater outside of the classroom only.
7. Non-uniform days are scheduled occasionally. Modesty and good taste are expected at all times. Sleeveless/tank/crop tops and sandals are not acceptable. Leggings and jeggings are acceptable as long as the top is long enough to cover the student's bottom. Rules #1 and #2 continue to apply on non-uniform days and at all school functions.
8. It is the parents' role, as well as the school's, to enforce the dress code. A written note signed by a parent must be received each day that a child is not in uniform.
9. Students who come to school inappropriately dressed will not be admitted to class. When there is a question regarding the appropriateness of attire, the principal will make the final decision.

Parents and students, sign and return one copy to school.
Please keep the other copy for easy reference while shopping for school.
